

RESOLUTION NO. 04-07
CITY OF WEST LINN, OREGON

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST LINN CERTIFYING THE RESULTS OF THE ELECTION ON MEASURE 3-117 ENTITLED "ANNEXATION OF WEST LINN TO TUALATIN VALLEY FIRE AND RESCUE" HELD ON MARCH 9, 2004.

WHEREAS, a special election was held in the City of West Linn on March 9, 2004; and

WHEREAS, one of the measures on the ballot was Measure 3-117; and

WHEREAS, the caption, question and summary for Measure 3-117 were as follows:

ANNEXATION OF WEST LINN TO TUALATIN VALLEY FIRE AND
RESCUE

QUESTION: Shall West Linn annex to Tualatin Valley Fire and Rescue to receive fire and emergency services?

SUMMARY: If approved by West Linn voters, this measure would annex the territory within the City to Tualatin Valley Fire and Rescue ("TVF&R"), for the limited purpose of receiving fire and emergency services. If the annexation occurs, TVF&R would take ownership of the city buildings and equipment currently being used to provide fire protection, prevention and emergency services within the City, and would staff the facilities on a permanent basis pursuant to an intergovernmental agreement with the City. TVF&R's permanent tax rate of \$1.5252 per thousand dollars of assessed value would be assessed on real property located within the City, effective July 1, 2004, as well as a 25-cent local option levy that is due to expire on July 1, 2005. Also by agreement, the tax rate assessed by the District would not exceed \$1.89 per thousand for a minimum of five years. Upon the effective date of the assessment of property taxes by TVF&R, the City of West Linn would cease to assess or collect property taxes within the City for fire and emergency services; and

WHEREAS, the votes have been counted by the Clackamas County Elections Division and the results submitted to the City for certification; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST LINN THAT:

Section 1: The City Council certifies that the votes on Measure 3-117 were:
Yes: 5,182
No: 670
Over Votes: 0
Under Votes: 19

Section 2: The City Council certifies that a majority of the votes cast were in favor of Measure 3-117 and that Measure 3-117 therefore passed.

Section 3: This resolution is effective immediately upon adoption.
